Socialization and Obedience Classes for the family Dog

The Spring class for Obedience Training and Socialization will begin Monday, April 25, 2022 at 8:30 p.m. at the 4-H Building located at the Wadena County Fair Grounds

Equipment needed: 6 ft training lead (Leather or Web) No chain leads
Training collar, Gentle Leader or Halti Collar
Up to date vaccination records

Dress to be comfortable (both shoe and clothing). You will be doing a lot of walking.

Don't feed your dog before classes or you will be doing a lot of clean-up. We do have cleaning materials available, also bags for picking up on the grounds outside the building.

In addition to the beginning class, we do offer advanced obedience training for those dogs having completed the beginner course. This will involve introducing off-lead training on the heeling, sit, sit stay and down stay, stand for exam and recall exercises. Also agility training is available in our spring session which is both fun for the dog as well as for you. Your dog will jump over hurdles, walk the A frame, go through a tunnel and stay on the pause table. We also offer Rally classes as well if anyone is interested.
